MOVING FORWARD TOGETHER WITH EU EXPERTISE



Aim of the Study visit:

With the ETS MRVA legal framework in place the Serbian Ministry of Environmental Protection wants to enhance the capacity on accreditation and verification in the scope of EU ETS. The Accreditation Body of Serbia (ATS) is in the process of setting up an accreditation scheme for ETS in Serbia and as a member of the European Cooperation for Accreditation it has started to actively participate in EA activities regarding ETS. During the process of formulating the legal framework the Ministry has been informing various stakeholders on future ETS activities, which among others resulted in several parties that have indicated an interest to become an accredited ETS verifier. Following an earlier workshop on accreditation of verifiers, the Ministry is now organising a workshop for verification of monitoring plans and emissions reports.

The aim of this workshop is enhance expertise in ETS verification in Serbia and in the entire region. Specifically it aims to support stakeholders in Serbia to prepare for actual accreditation as ETS verifier. After this workshop the potential verifiers would be ready to conduct their tasks under an ETS planned to be operated in Serbia, along the lines of the EU ETS.
