It will support to increase the uptake of the Covenant of Mayors for climate and energy initiatives in the country and supporting local authorities to turn their ambitions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions into reality and improve resilience to the impacts of climate change via climate change adaptation, taking into account local diversity. Local authorities like municipalities will be empowered to participate in multi-level governance for energy and climate policy development and implementation.
