Aim of the Workshop:

The aim of the workshop is to provide advice so as to strengthen beneficiary's efforts toward national adaptation plans and to identify linkages to disaster risk reduction and natural hazard management. Best practice guidance through the presentation of case studies will be delivered to support policymakers, governmental and administrative officials as well as experts at the sub-national level.

The workshop will further promote exchanges between beneficiary partners through knowledge-sharing and brokering good practices. In addition, experiences and lessons learned from European countries, macro-regions and transnational cooperation areas as well as other actors will support strengthening of cooperation and collaboration.

The overarching objective of the workshop is to support policy makers and technical officials in the Western Balkans and Turkey in adaptation policy making by setting the scene and brokering available knowledge and approaches. As an integral part of addressing the adverse impacts of climate change through medium and long-term National Adaptation Plans (NAP), a focus will be on the relevance of disaster risk reduction and natural hazard management at the transnational scale.
