Regional Training on carbon pricing - Workshop Rationale

Carbon pricing systems put an explicit price on carbon emissions so that the costs of climate impacts and the opportunities for low-carbon energy options are better reflected in our production and consumption choices. As (future) EU accession countries the beneficiary countries are preparing for implementation of carbon pricing.

The workshop aims to update participants on recent developments in carbon pricing at global level and specifically in the EU and in the region. Specific aim is to help prepare the future EU ETS participants and observers in the beneficiary states on the requirements and potential impacts of a price on carbon emissions in their region.
