Aim of the Workshop:

The Workshop will focus on the implementation of the Energy Union strategy in the Western Balkans (WB) and Turkey, and on the status of their drafted National Energy and Climate Plans (NECPs). Representatives of the beneficiaries will present their Quality Assurance and Quality Control (QA/QC) procedures together with their plans for monitoring, reporting and verification (MRV). During the workshop, the methods on how the NECPs can be checked for consistency, comprehensiveness and conformity with the Governance Regulation will be discussed, as well as the major requirements of the European Commission. In addition, stated targets will be discussed and the experiences of the experts and Beneficiaries exchanged, in particular with respect to gaps and challenges as well as expected changes in the governance framework in order to ensure NECP implementation.
