The objective of the workshop is to discuss the regional capacity for developing low emission development strategies, support in implementation of the priority actions under the long-term strategy and its action plan, if already existing in the countries.

LTS-LEDS development requires an inclusive process, ensuring ownership and involvement of all relevant stakeholders across key sectors of the economy, so the workshop will support Tratolow countries to introduce and gain broad support for the LT-LEDS concept and assist in the environmentally sound, sustainability focused, long-term planning.
