Aim of the Workshop:

The overarching objective of the workshop is to focus on latest developments in adaptation MRE at national level mostly in Europe. It looks into countries that have gained practical experience in monitoring and evaluating their national adaptation strategies and plans to share their lessons learnt and discuss their approaches to commonly faced challenges with Bosnia and Herzegovinian colleagues. Specific topics to be addressed include stakeholder engagement, the role of adaptation indicators in monitoring, reporting and evaluation, and the use of knowledge generated by MRE efforts to improve and further promote policy and practice.

In addition, the workshop reflects on the links of national MRE activities to knowledge needs at different levels of governance (local and international) and provides an interactive space where experiences and lessons learned from the speakers and participants can feed into MRE practice in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The domestic workshop aims at raising the awareness for the need for adaptation indicators and monitoring and provide a platform for exchanging experience and taking stock of recent developments on, and potential for future deployment of indicators and monitoring for climate change adaptation.
