Aim of the Workshop:

The objective is to provide advice and guidance to the national Greenhouse Gas (GHG) inventory teams for each sector on the filling of CRF tables by using the latest available CRF software web application, including linkages to calculation files, and quality control procedures. The CRF file for one year consists of 96 tables covering summary information, sectoral emission tables, indirect emissions, key categories, information on notation keys, recalculations, methods and emission factors used, trend tables, improvements and Kyoto Protocol specific tables (supplementary information for land use, land-use change and forestry activities under the Kyoto Protocol).

Sector experts from beneficiary countries will be especially made familiar with the corresponding CRF tables to ensure that the necessary background data is collected, together with data for calculating emissions at the required level of disaggregation for reporting.

A focus will be that all participants understand the different notation keys and their purpose, whereby the definitions and explanations provided in the "2006 IPCC guidelines for National Greenhous Gas Inventories" and the "Good Practise Guidance and Uncertainty Management in National Greenhouse Gas Inventories" are the basis.
